The role of LACCD's Title IX Coordinators is to:
 Provide information about available Campus and District options, including the LACCD complaint process

- Explore potential response measures, including campus-specific options, such as a Mutual No-Contact Order
- Help parties contact the Campus Sheriff
- Help parties file a complaint with LACCD to initiate an investigation
- Explore options for Early Resolution of complaints
- Connect parties with resources, on and off campus
