- **COVID-19 Public Health Emergency**
 - Board Policies 2800 & 2900 currently remain in force until modified
 - Los Angeles County remains at “Low Risk” for community transmission, but new positive cases are up due to new variants
 - County Health Orders status quo, but contract tracing for colleges and universities being streamlined
 - Nation appears to be entering Endemic phase vs. Pandemic, as we learn to live with C-19
 - Next LACCD Telebriefing with County Health is today
 - LACCD EOC and Colleges’ ICC on track to demobilize in June



BOARD POLICIES 2800 & 2900



CHANCELLOR'S RECOMMENDATION

Based on low transmission and low hospitalization rates countywide and with LACCD employees and students, staff, the following are recommended changes to the COVID-related policies:

- **Fully rescind BP 2800 as of June 12, 2022**
- **Amend BP 2900 such that there will be no student vaccination requirement**
- **Recommend that fully vaccinated status, which does not include boosters, continue as a condition of employment for all employees**

It is also recommended that each college promote a health campaign to assure that all employees and students have information regarding vaccinations, testing and masking – with access to these as well at the campuses.

Moving forward, the goal will be that individuals take the initiative to keep themselves safe and healthy rather than using employer policies and discipline.

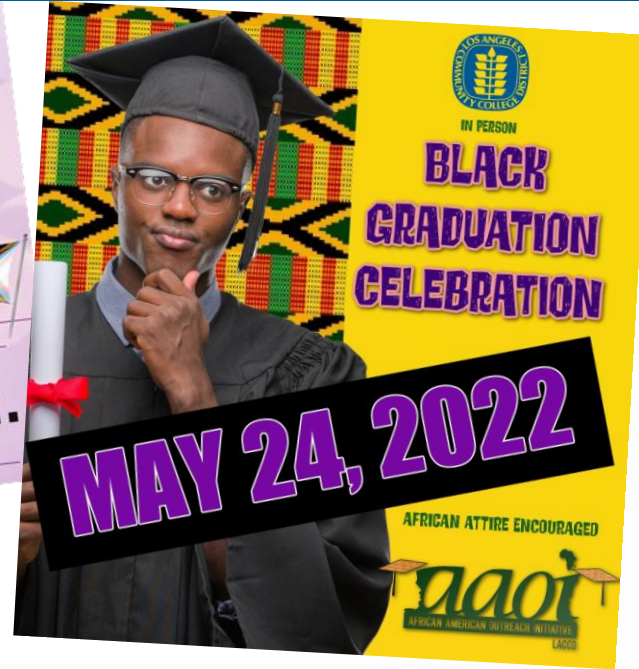
