They will direct you to the your reserved spaces in Lot 1

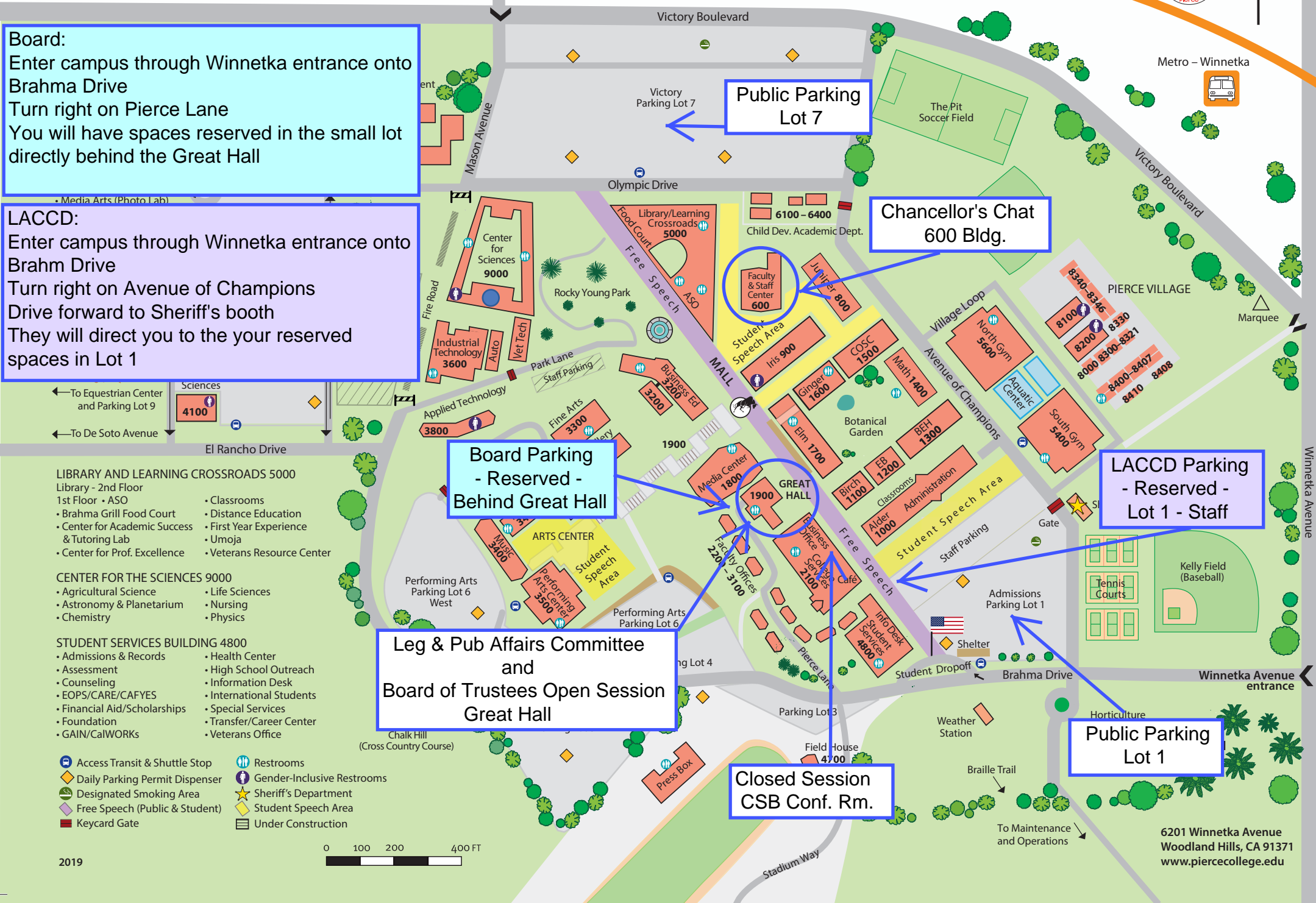
