- West Los Angeles College Facilities Master Plan Review

A document entitled “West Los Angeles College, 2013 Facilities Master Plan Update” was distributed.

Mr. James O’Reilly indicated that today’s presentation is a continuation of the last Committee meeting to clarify questions that were brought forth.

Mr. Nabil Abu-Ghazaleh gave a PowerPoint presentation and discussed the document with respect to the West Los Angeles Community College (WLAC) Facilities Master Plan regarding wide range of local and regional industries served, the average historic annual growth rate, the current and projected instructional facility needs and noted the State standard for instructional capacity, campus footprint and maintenance and operations budget (M&O), the proposed 2013 Long-Range Facilities Master Plan, and the priorities toward 2026 instructional space needs.

Trustee Moreno expressed his concern that the enrollment projections are based on assumptions and are not realistic.

A question and answer session was conducted regarding the construction program building plan for 2026 through 2036 as it relates to various enrollment growth components, State standard, and space utilization.

Motion by Trustee Svonkin, seconded by Trustee Veres, to recommend to the full Board approval of the WLAC 2013 Facilities Master Plan Update.
