**Brief Summary of the Topic(s) Discussed**

The following individuals addressed the Committee concerning the proposed Board resolution with respect to the lack of clarity in terms of the Los Angeles Community College Bureau of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Sheriff's role on campus if Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) arrives on campus seeking immigration status of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) students.

Ms. Kenia Alcocer, Mr. Javier Lopez, Ms. Sarah Isabel Contreras, and Ms. Olga Shewfelt.

Addressed the speakers concerns with respect various activities and procedures being implemented to inform students that the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department role on campus is not to initiate police activity with the objective of discovering an individual's immigration status (Captain Armalin).

Indicated that new language will be added to the proposed Board resolution in order to address the students concern regarding the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department role in case ICE arrives on campus unannounced (Trustee Hoffman and Chancellor Francisco C. Rodriguez).

Discussed the progress made to resolve Los Angeles Southwest College's (LASC) Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC) recommendations 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 (Dr. Denise Noldon, President, LASC; Dr. Lawrence Bradford, Vice President, Academic Affairs; and Dr. Ralph Davis, Accreditation Faculty Co-Chair/Chair of Counseling's; and Mr. Alfred Gallegos, Dean of Instructional Advancement).

Discussed the LACCD student application process (Dr. Ryan M. Cornner, Vice Chancellor, Educational Programs and Institutional Effectiveness; Mr. Joel Trudgen, Student Recruitment Coordinator, Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC); and Dr. Kanessha Tarrant, Vice President Student Services, Los Angeles Trade Technical College (LATTC).

A PowerPoint presentation was conducted of the 2018-23 District Strategic Plan (DSP) with respect to various activities and the planning process in terms of the development of the DSP proposed goals (Mr. Maury Pearl, Associate Vice Chancellor, Institutional Effectiveness and Dr. Cornner).

With respect to the PowerPoint presentation entitled "DSP Progress Report and Planning Activities Marketing Goal," Trustees Hoffman and Kamlager recommended that this be presented to the full Board.

With respect to DSP Goals III. Objective 6: We will increase access to those traditionally underrepresented in higher education by assisting students in gaining access to financial aid and ensuring that all students, whether in-person or online, receive orientation, multiple measures assessment, and educational planning, Trustee Kamlager recommended that this be redefined in terms of "traditionally underrepresented" to include Foster Youth, homeless students, and formerly incarcerated students.
