



FIVE LACCD COLLEGES HOSTING VACCINATION CLINICS JUNE 18-20; NEW DISTRICTWIDE \$75 INCENTIVE ANNOUNCED FOR STUDENTS

LOS ANGELES—Five of the colleges from the Los Angeles Community College District ([LACCD](#)) are hosting free COVID-19 vaccination clinics this weekend, June 18-20, to help get their students and the public vaccinated. It is the latest effort by LACCD's colleges to help serve students and the local communities where the colleges are located in a cooperative effort with the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health.

Clinics are being held this weekend at various times, beginning today, Friday, June 18, through Sunday, June 20. Participating colleges include **West Los Angeles College, Los Angeles City College, Los Angeles Pierce College, Los Angeles Southwest College** and **Los Angeles Mission College**. Check the specific schedule below.

A variety of incentives are being offered to LACCD students to get vaccinated now. In addition to what each college is offering, the Foundation for the Los Angeles Community Colleges announced today it is offering a districtwide incentive of \$75 to each student who gets vaccinated. The Foundation received a grant from Kaiser Permanente to make the incentive possible, according to Michael Fuller, Director of Institutional Advancement for LACCD.

Kaiser Permanente has joined the White House for its [National Month of Action](#) to vaccinate at least 70 percent of U.S. adults against COVID-19 with at least one shot by July 4. Kaiser Permanente is launching several programs or incentives for unvaccinated individuals to increase confidence in the safety and effectiveness of the vaccine and provide easy access to vaccines.

LACCD students are encouraged to use the college-hosted clinics, but any LACCD student with a valid vaccination card dated on or after June 16 can apply for the \$75 incentive. If a student brings a friend or family member to get vaccinated, they can receive a maximum of \$150, until all funds are used, Fuller said. LACCD students must apply to the Foundation via the LACCD student portal [using the "Kaiser Max the Vax" link](#).

Clinic schedule per college show below. Unvaccinated participants should wear facemasks and observe social distancing. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. Dates and times subject to weather and supplies permitting.

[West Los Angeles College](#), Friday, June 18, 9:30 – 11:30 a.m. In partnership with Kedren Health. Drive-ins and walk-ins are welcome. The first 100 WLAC students to be vaccinated will receive \$25 WLAC Bookstore gift cards. Students also will have the opportunity to be entered in a drawing to receive a laptop.

[Los Angeles City College](#), Saturday, June 19, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. "Max Vax" event in partnership with Kedren Health. **Friday, Saturday and Sunday, 7 a.m. – 3 p.m.**, Wesley / Student Health Center. On-site college incentives, plus districtwide incentive eligible.

[Los Angeles Southwest College](#), Friday, June 18 and Saturday, June 19, 8 a.m. – 8 p.m. Look for entry signs to Parking Lot 8. Vaccination site in cooperation with the Los Angeles City Fire Department. LACCD students are eligible for the Districtwide incentive but using this site also qualifies for entry into the County's [sweepstakes](#) opportunity.
