For anyone who will be a first-time, full-time student for the Fall 2021 semester—especially recent high school graduates—you have until August 1, 2021 to join the [Los Angeles College Promise Program](#) (LACP) with its tuition-free scholarship opportunity for two years. All new students must first start their enrollment process [online](#) by applying to one of the nine colleges. Once a completed application is submitted, a new student will receive a unique identification number and LACCD email address. Students then go to the [student portal](#) page ([MyCollege.laccd.edu](http://MyCollege.laccd.edu)), create a new password and click on the "Manage Classes" (add/drop) icon to enroll in classes at any of the nine colleges.

If you want to enroll as a first-time, full-time student as part of the L.A. College Promise program, use your new student ID to fill out the short "[interest form](#)" at the [Los Angeles College Promise Program](#) website and you will be contacted after submitting the form.
