

ARTICLE I

DEFINITION OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE

1100. ORGANIZATION BY GRADES. “Community College” means freshman and sophomore years in a two-year college. The title, “Los Angeles Community College District,” will be the official name of the “Los Angeles two-year colleges”.

1101. HIGHER EDUCATION. Community colleges are part of higher education by definition and function and by their being included in the California Post-secondary Education Commission.
