## COMPLIANCE AWARENESS

The [Los Angeles Community College District](#) is committed to assisting employees with issues that may arise in the workplace. Policies and procedures are focused on addressing issues in their earliest stages.

Each location of the District has a [Compliance Officer](#) specially trained in a compliance issues. In addition, the [District Office's Office of Diversity Programs](#) provides oversight on a Districtwide basis and serves as a resource on relevant issues, provides assistance for employees with a disability, and coordinates employee support training and faculty workshops;

In addition, state statute and/or federal law require the following:

- All employees, except student employees, [Child Abuse Identification and Training](#) (CANRA). This training is available on line. For assistance with this requirement, contact Services Unit, Human Resources, District Office.
- Supervisory employees have sexual harassment training as specified by Assembly Bill 1825. The Office of Diversity Programs, District Office, notifies employees who meet the supervisory requirement when the training sessions are scheduled. The Compliance Officer at your location will notify you when your training is scheduled.
- All colleges and universities that receive federal funding are required by the Jeanne Clery Act, formerly known as the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act, to disclose information about the crime on campus and crime in the immediate vicinity of the campus. Complete Jeanne Clery Disclosure information is available from the Sheriff's Station located on each campus, posted on college websites, and printed in the schedules of classes.
