Call to Order at 9:15am.

Approval of Agenda as amended (Immerblum/Bruzzese MSC). Unanimous. Approval as amended of Minutes of June 17, 2016 Meeting (Milke/Bruzzese MSC).

Public Speakers: Linda Delzeit (LA Trade Tech, member of DAS Online Ed Committee). Delzeit asked the DAS Senate to consider forming—in parallel to District Academic Curriculum Committee—a District Academic Technology Committee that helps determine policies and procedures regarding technology, e.g. digital badging (certification of digital competency for platforms): Delzeit asked why DE Coordinators control instructor access to teach on Canvas, instead of having instructors be responsible for their own training. Technology issues are arising that are beyond the purview of local DE committees. Delzeit reported that Trade Tech has separated Informational Technology issues from Academic Technology issues. Miller recommends immediately forming DAS Academic Technology workgroup on this issue; Miller and El-Khoury have volunteered to serve on this workgroup. Gauthier has asked for campus representatives to serve on this workgroup.

Action Items:

- 1. Motion: Encourage the adoption of new guidelines for Associate Degree for Transfer Reciprocity in the LACCD: (Atondo/McMurray MSC). Unanimous.
- 2. Themes/Ideas for 2016 Summit Planning (Monday, July 18, 2:30-3:30) (discussion). Gauthier suggested discussion of plans and goals.

3. Motion to create DAS/PDC Web page updater (discussion): Fusilero will update as part of his position as secretary. Brent suggests bringing Ayesha Randall LATTC) into this discussion.

Old Business:

- 1. Collaborative Brain Trust (CBT)-Intellus GenEd Basic Skills Pilot (discussion):
 Gauthier reported that the pilot demonstration was Friday, July 8. Brent had misgivings about the program as the presentation did not seem to focus on basic skills, but rather on science. Gauthier said that other instructors thought that the program had promise.
- 2. Food, Local Senate Dues, and District Senate Dues (discussion): Immerblum explained the process for local senate presidents to submit fund requests.
- 3. Board Rule Chap. X, Article III Selection Policies (progress report): Gauthier met with HR to discuss changes in language of Board Rule X.III. Gauthier and HR are also working on language regarding adjunct hiring and MQs. Gauthier is still working on language for selection of chancellor. Immerblum wants to make sure that district has uniform policy on hiring of adjunct faculty as well as of chancellor.
