1. Community Facilitator I, II, III, Lead Staff, Community Trainer (Various)

Teach community safety and awareness, social interactions & self help skills. Minimum of 2 years experience supporting adults, young adults or children with developmental disabilities. Facilitate appropriate interactions. Portray a good role model. Seeking dedicated individuals to support children with disabilities.

2. Financial Advisor Assistant (Woodland Hills)
