## **New Update on 2021 Cal OSHA Emergency Temporary Standards**

**June 11, 2021**

Colleagues:

The District's Emergency Operations Center is providing this new update to you with the latest information regarding workplace safety requirements by the Cal OSHA Board. Earlier this week, we sent to you an email with the latest information about the Cal OSHA requirements from the agency's meeting on June 3. The Cal OSHA Board met again on June 9 and voted to rescind its own action from June 3 until a new set of standards could be considered later this month.

Here is the [news release](#) announcing the action taken. In summary, Cal OSHA's requirements for facial coverings, social distancing and screening that were approved in November 2020 stand. For LACCD, this means our existing protocols remain, with no changes for us. It is possible that the Cal OSHA Board will meet again as early as June 17 to consider next steps. This situation is changing quickly and the District is closely following these developments. We will continue to keep you informed as soon as possible. Thank you.
