

Understanding Stocks & Bonds	Students in this class will learn detailed knowledge about stocks and bonds, including the language and terminology of the stock and bond markets, trading techniques, strategies for asset allocation and rebalancing, the impact of rising interest rates, differences between 'common' versus 'preferred' stocks, and the differences between 'government', 'mortgage-backed', 'municipal' and 'corporate' bonds.

**Mutual Funds &
Annuities Explained**

Students in this class will learn about mutual funds and annuities, including the differences of 'load versus no-load' and 'index versus managed mutual funds', the expenses, costs, and risks of mutual funds and annuities- including fixed, variable and index annuities, 'death benefit guarantees' and 'living benefit guarantees' that annuities provide, the importance of tax deferral, how to select the right mutual fund or annuity, as well as techniques such as rebalancing and asset allocation.
