COVID-19 STATUS

- Cal/OSHA expected to revise "workplace" safety rules tomorrow, June 3
- California anticipated re-opening, June 15
- District, Colleges are now working on "demobilization" of the District Emergency Operations Center and Colleges' Incident Command Centers



COVID-19 STATUS: VACCINATIONS

- LACCD Planning to Host Vaccination Clinics at All Nine Colleges in June
 - Pierce and Southwest working with L.A. City Fire Dept.
 - East is paired with Rite-Aid under Biden Administration national plan
 - Harbor working with Providence
 - City, Mission, Trade-Tech, Valley and West responding to L.A.
 County Department of Public Health for additional community clinics






- Fall 2021 Re-Engagement Plans
 - Fall Semester planning assumption remains 50% on-site instruction and student services
 - All sites are increasing in-person operations and services beginning in June
 - Consultation with employee groups continues
 - Situation rapidly changing and remains dynamic

- Mandatory Online Training with modules for students and staff in compliance with IHE protocols





District Safety and Stability

Creating safe places to work and study at all Colleges & District facilities

- Vent cleaning at all locations before August
- Deep cleaning & sanitization at all locations
- HVAC filter upgrades
- Altering HVAC sequence for outside air where possible
- Custodial dispatch and staffing for daily cleaning of classrooms used
- Ensuring cleaning and PPE supplies available
- Coordinating with Colleges for fall schedules and cleaning needs



Check-In Process

- Revisions expected with new Cal/OSHA rules
- County expects to stop its check-in & screening process
- District must still report cases for Workers'
 Comp to State and any new outbreaks to
 County
