

## Chromebook Setup Guide

- 1. When you first open your Chromebook, it will automatically turn on and you will be greeted with the Welcome screen. Click Let's go to continue.
  - a. If the Chromebook does not turn on automatically, press the power button on the top right corner of the keyboard. If it still doesn't turn on, charge it for 15 minutes, then try again.



2. Next, you will see a list of available Wi-Fi networks in your area. Select your network, type in the Wi-Fi password, then click on Connect.

3. To use your Chromebook, you will need to agree to the Chrome OS terms. Click on Accept and continue to proceed.





- a. You can opt-out of automatically sending diagnostic and usage data to Google by turning off the switch, then click Accept and continue.
- 4. You will need a Gmail account to use your Chromebook. Type in your email address and password to proceed.
