ADDENDUM NO. 3

IFB NO. 21-08 SOLID WASTE AND RECYLCING SERVICES

The following questions were received by the established deadline. Responses follow each question.

1) **QUESTION:** Will the Service Provider bring their own MSW 3-yd bins to West Los Angeles College (WLAC) or service/dump the bins that are owned by WLAC?

RESPONSE: WLAC desires that the Service Provider service/dump the bins owned by WLAC. No Service Provider MSW 3-yd bins are needed.

2) **QUESITON**: Scout Service was noted in the IFB narrative for Los Angeles Southwest College (LASC), with the bin placements noted during the Job Walk it appears that Scout Service is no longer needed – correct?

RESPONSE: That is correct. Scout Service is not needed at LASC.

3) **QUESTION**: Which locations will need Scout Service – either via tow out by a smaller vehicle or push out to an area where they can be serviced by a front loader?

RESPONSE: West Los Angeles College (WLAC) and Los Angeles City College (LACC) are the two locations specifically noted with Scout Service via either tow out or push out service. As a courtesy, reminders have been noted for Bidders on those respective facility bid sheets.

4) **QUESTION:** Many statements were made about the unknown return to campus population, which directly impacts the volumes of materials generated. Historic tonnage has been provided, however, how does the District want this to be bid for a fair and accurate comparison of Bidder services in relation to volume? Would the District be open to providing agreed upon compactor and roll-off bin average weights to be used for bid purposes only?

RESPONSE: The District recognizes the challenges around available weights on some material streams and not others, as well as the varying size of compactors. Based upon the mutual and collective in-person agreement by all representatives from each of the Bidder organizations, the District is willing to include the mutually agreed upon average weights for compactors and roll-off bins and make related clarifying modifications to the Bid Sheets.

As part of this response, the District has made the following material change to the IFB Bid Document:

Attachment 1 – BID FORMS AND MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS QUESTIONAIRE has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with Attachment 1A – BID FORMS AND MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS QUESTIONNAIRE.

Bidders shall utilize and complete Attachment 1A.

5) **QUESTION:** For the projection of future costs after the first year of the agreement term, exactly how is the Consumer Price Index (CPI) to be applied for Years Two (2) and Three (3)?

RESPONSE: Beyond the description provided in Attachment 1A, the following clarification is provided. For the benefit of a longer-term contract with the District, the District will follow the noted Consumer Price Index (CPI) as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, for All Urban Consumers, Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County Area. Understanding that facility tipping fees, some of which may not be owned by the Bidder, may likely increase during the contract term Bidders are asked to clearly describe what portion of their service costs relate may relate to facility tipping fees upon which increases may likely be outside the scope of CPI increase.

6) **QUESTION:** Additionally, for the calculation of the rate for Option Years Four (4) and Five (5) – how should this be factored?

RESPONSE: The District offers the opportunity for Bidders to take the average cost of their aggregate 3-year rate projections (through which there will be adjustments based upon the success of their recycling and organics diversion efforts) and apply an estimated CPI (noted previously) for their following potential options on Years 4 (Four) -5 (Five). Again, bidders shall narrate what portion (percentage) of their service rates are related to facility tipping fees.

Bidders are expected to use these weights as a part of their calculations on each of the following facility bid pages.

Service Provider will only invoice LACCD for actual weights as documented by certified weight tickets from a properly permitted solid waste/recycling facility.

Take the Total Cost for Year 1 for each respective College or facility location and enter it into the **Bidders Cumulative Annual Service**Totals Table - Year One (1) – Year Three (3).

For Years Two (2) and Three (3), provide a projected estimated rate for total yearly services on each location. The Consumer Price Index (CPI) as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, for All Urban Consumers, Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County Area shall be utilized as the method for projecting costs for Years Two (2) and Three (3). Bidder shall provide narrative, attached separately to their Bidder's Cumulative Annual Service Totals Table – Year One (1) – Three (3), to describe their rate increase projections and calculations, specifically denoting what portion of their rates relates to facility tipping fees.

Tally the numbers for Years One (1), Two (2), and Three (3) into the final **Bid Total – Service Totals Year 1-3.** The low bid price will be the aggregate of the annualized prices for Years One (1), Two (2) and Three (3). This is the cumulative Year One (1) – Year Three (3) costs which shall be the number reviewed at the bid opening.

Finally, for calculation of the rate for Option Years Four (4) and Five (5): each additional option year shall be based on the annual average cost of a 3-year aggregate bid, plus an estimated CPI index noted above, that is compounded for each additional year. Bidders shall enter their calculated costs onto **Bidder's Reference Worksheet – Years 4 (Four) - 5 (Five)**.

- Subsequent to establishment of the required recycling and organics recycling collection programs, services are adjusted for changed volumes generated;
- The opening of currently inactive dining services requiring organics recycling collection services;
- A newly added facility requiring services; and,
- The lease of a District facility (or portion thereof) to a tenant ends requiring service reduction or discontinuation.

Bidders are required to complete the **CONFIDENTIAL - PER TON TIPPING FEE BY LACCD MATERIAL & FACILITY** form that provides a Per Unit Cost and a Tipping Fee Rate naming the facilities where each respective material type will be disposed or tipped and each facility's per ton tipping fee.

BIDDERS ARE REMINDED – Bids shall not be based solely on estimated tonnages. Please read bid document for complete information. BE CERTAIN that pricing for services is inclusive of the requirements noted within the bid document in Section VI. Required Services, Specifications and General Conditions, which is inclusive of but not limited to: Education, Outreach, Containers (Section VI. A. 2.b.), Staff Training and Reporting.

Where questions may arise regarding service type, volume or tonnage, based upon the Job Walks conducted April 25-27 and final evaluation, the following REVISED Bid Sheets shall prevail. Bidders understand that service needs may fluctuate based upon evolving hybrid versus in-person teaching approaches employed individually by each campus.
