### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY DOMINGUEZ HILLS (CSUDH) AND LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (LACCD)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on the effective date of Julys, 2023, by California State University, Dominguez Hills (CSUDH) and Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD), Hereinafter Jointus, reference to as \*Feducational. Institutions, The parties argee to estre into this agreement for the mutual education in institutions and their students and to facilitate LACCD students' successful enrollment, refernion and graduation at CSUDAL.

CSUDH AND LACCD BELIEVE THAT EXISTING LOCAL COLLEGE PARTICIPATION RATES AND SUCCESS ARE LESS THAN SATISFACTORY AND IMPROVED THROUGH A SYSTEMATIC, FOUUSED, AND COLLABORATIVE EFFORT. THE LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT CONSISTS OF NINE COLLEGES, EAST LOS ANGELES COLLEGE (ELAPC), LOS ANGELES COLLEGE (LAPC), AND WEST LOS ANGELES COLLEGE (MACO).
