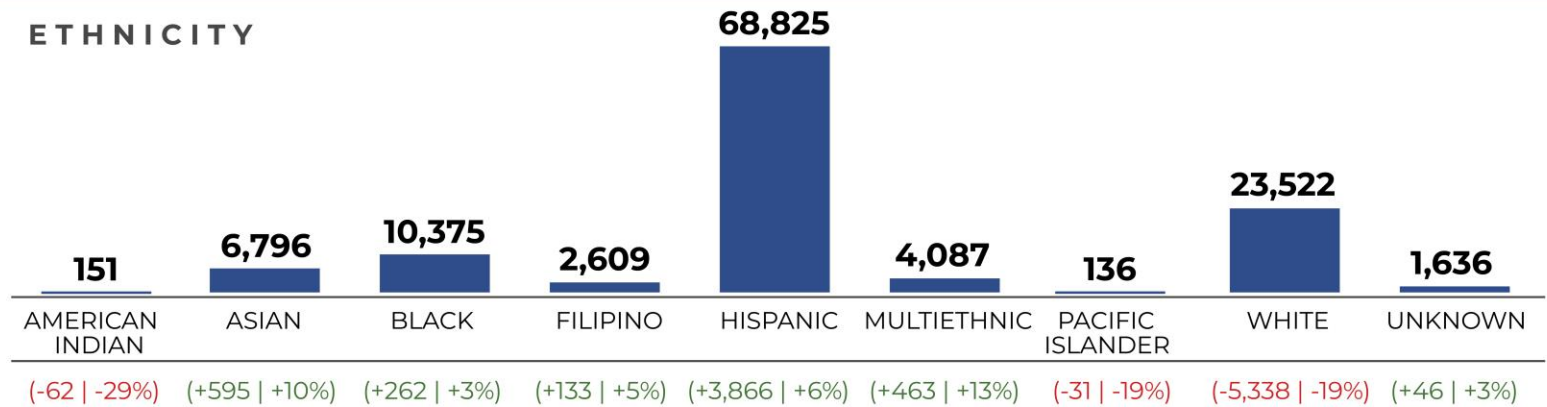

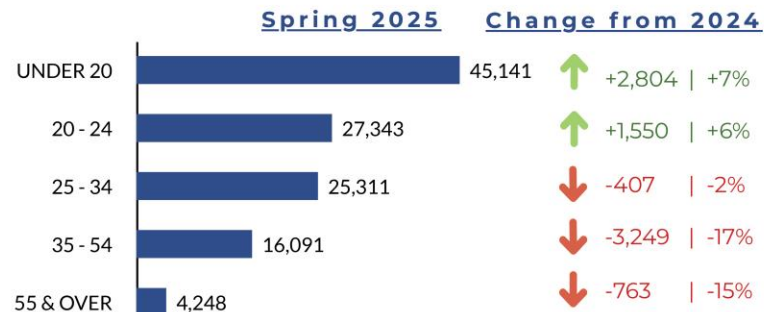

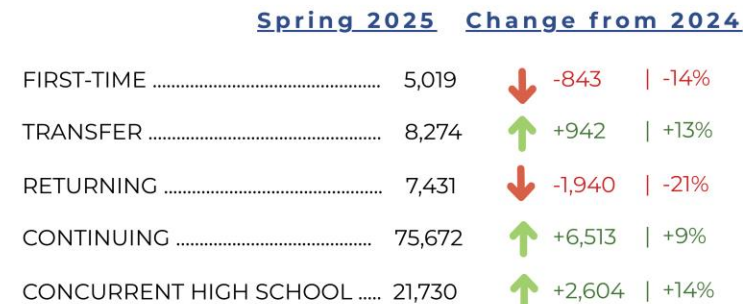
## ETHNICITY

# Enrollment Update – Spring 2025



## **Spring 2025 Enrollment Update:**

*Comparing Spring 2025 to Spring 2024 (as day 49 of the semester)*

### **Districtwide**

- Student credit headcount is unchanged
- Enrollment is up by 2%
- Class offerings are unchanged
- Enrollment per section is up by 1%
  - 48% of classes are being taught remotely
  - 44% are in-person
  - 8% are hybrid
- Remote classes have the highest fill rate (84%) followed by hybrid (74%) and in-person classes (70%).



# In-Language Summit Results

## Statewide In-language Education Summit

With over **190 attendees** joining the webinar, the summit sparked a powerful discussion on how expanding in-language learning supports diverse student populations, enhances enrollment, and strengthens access to higher education.

We also touched on ongoing legislative efforts, including **AB 1096 (Fong)**, aimed at improving language accessibility across California's community colleges.

LACCD has taken a major step in addressing student housing insecurity with the launch of its comprehensive housing program.

These Requests for Proposals (RFP) mark the beginning of a strategic initiative to provide safe and reliable housing options for LACCD students:

- **Properties for Delivery of Housing to LACCD Students – Due April 30, 2025**
  - RFP includes the following options:
    - Existing property
    - Building under construction
    - Vacant property
  - Prequalifying Meetings:
    - April 8 and April 14
- **Short-term and Emergency Student Housing – March 21, 2024 – Committee reviewing proposals.**
