## EAST LOS ANGELES COLLEGE

East Los Angeles College is the largest community college in California, consisting of multiple campuses with state-of-the-art facilities, over 300+ degree and certificate programs, and 32 majors. Located in Monterey Park, CA, ELAC serves over 47,000 students a year ranging from traditional college-aged students to senior citizens. In addition to a 22,000 seat football stadium, ELAC boasts a number of fully equipped theaters, including the Ingalls Auditorium, which is one of the largest in Southern California, and the Vincent Price Art Museum.

In 1997, the South Gate Educational Center was established to extend ELAC's reach to the growing student population in that area. The college now offers classes in dozens of locations across East Los Angeles at local high schools and community centers.

ELAC is accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC), Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

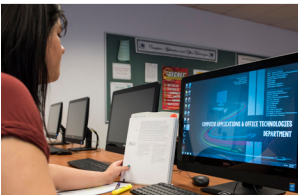
